




## Home-Visits



If you have difficulty getting to healthcare due to mobility issues, then you may benefit from our home-visit service.

A home-visit is similar to a clinical office visit, except it takes place in the home of a homebound patient. If you are a homebound person, getting to your provider's office for an office visit is difficult and stressful, and may actually have negative effects on your health. That's why we offer home-visits.

During a home-visit, a provider comes to your home and addresses your health issues. In this way, the stress and difficulty caused by leaving home to get healthcare is avoided.

At Cascade Family Care, our home-visit service is offered to anyone who is homebound. Our provider comes out to your home and offers primary healthcare to you on a monthly basis.

### Are home-visits covered by my insurance?

Yes, your insurance most likely does cover home-visits; most insurances do. If you are not sure whether your insurance will cover these services, contact your insurance company.



### Are there any differences between home-visits and office visits?

There are not many differences between home-visits and office-visits aside from the location in which they take place. Home visits are covered by almost all insurances, just like office visits. Most simple procedures (such as referrals, blood draws injections, drug screens, minor surgeries, etc.) can be performed during a home visit.

### How do I know if I qualify as homebound?



Your provider is the person who determines whether or not you are homebound. There are some general guidelines which he/she may use to determine this:

- Person has difficulty leaving the home due to an illness or injury.
- When leaving the home, a considerable and taxing effort is required.

Generally, people considered to be homebound cannot leave their home without:

- The use of supportive devices (crutches, wheelchair, walker, etc.)
- The use of special transportation
- and/or the assistance of another person.

In the end, however, it is up to your provider to determine whether or not you qualify as homebound.

### Does my provider offer home-visit services?

Here at Cascade Family Care, we have been doing home visits since we opened our doors in 2005.

There are not many other primary care providers in the Salem area that offer home-visit services. The only way to determine whether your provider offers home-visit services is to contact his/her office. We encourage you to call your provider and ask.



### Will your clinic accept me as a homebound patient?

Yes, we will. We accept all insurances (including Medicare, Tricare Medicaid, and OHP), and we even accept patients without insurance. If you qualify as homebound, give us a call, and our provider can start offering primary care to you in your home.
